Key Security Features:

1. **Data Encryption:** All data transmitted between your device and our servers is encrypted using Secure Sockets Layer (SSL)/Transport Layer Security (TLS) protocols, ensuring that sensitive information remains protected during transmission.
2. **Data Privacy:** We adhere to state and federal regulations, including FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act) compliance, to protect the privacy of student and educational records.
3. **Secure Authentication:** Password policies are implemented to provide an additional layer of security for user accounts.
4. **Monitoring and Auditing:** Our system is continuously monitored for unusual activity, and audit logs are maintained to track access and changes to sensitive data.
